CEMETERY MASTER INDEX

(For Sites and Cemeteries – Books 1-12)

The reader will note several names are written twice and for the same name two burial places are given. This may be because the Mortuary record differs from the actual burial place and in other cases the bodies were moved from the original location. Because of the Oroville Dam construction, Bidwell Bar and Enterprise Cemeteries plus some individual grave sites were moved to Pioneer Cemetery next to Thompson Flat Cemetery off the Oregon Gulch Road. Pioneer Cemetery listings are found in Book 4. Some remains were moved to Oroville or Chico Cemeteries and placed in family plots.

There may be two listings of the same name since sons and daughters are named for living family members. In such instances dates should be checked. Note that Book 7 is printed in two parts, 1 and 2. We have sought accuracy but there are sometimes errors on the monument or in the recording of data. There is no question that many names are missing because no records were kept.

Larger cemeteries not listed in this effort are Paradise, Chico, Oroville, Gridley, Durham, Dayton, Cherokee, Stirling City, Magalia and Butte County Cemetery. Information on burials in these cemeteries may be obtained by writing to the Paradise Genealogical Society. Some of these may in the future be added to this Index.
