

De Sabla.

(Formerly Hupp's Mill and Hupp). It lies at an elevation of 2762 feet. It was named after one of the Pacific Gas and Electric founders and is the site of Lake De Sabla reservoir and a powerhouse named for him. It is shared with the community of Magalia.

The Hupp post office was opened in 1909 and changed its name to De Sabla in 1911. It closed in 1942. Hupp was named in honor of John Hupp the sawmill owner and was renamed in honor of Eugene De Sabla, who supervised the construction of the power generation plant in 1903
