Historical Museums.- I love Museums! All kinds of Museums – but especially Historical Museums! I love how they look, how they smell, how they feel, and the anticipation of what I might see. I love learning about the history of the area and the people that were there, how our ancestors lived; how they cooked, what they wore, the tools they used, the ways they traveled. What was a dentists' office like, a barber shop, a post office, a newspaper? All of it!

But, have you ever considered a Historical Museum as a genealogical research resource?

Perhaps someone donated an old City Directory which is not online and might list your Grandfather. Perhaps, when Great-Aunt Jane passed away, someone donated your family Bible that you've been wishing for? Or maybe your Great-Grand Parents wedding portraits? Or old school records of where your Great-Grandmother went to school and who her teachers were? Or her wedding dress? There may be old newspapers not on line, or – who knows?

Just recently, we visited two wonderful such museums, one in Forbestown – about an hour's drive from Chico and one in Fort Jones – about 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours away.

The Yuba Feather Museum in

Forbestown has a Family Research area with more than 300 family group records, 3,000 photographs, and other records on file. Staff members will assist with searches and internet

sources. It is worth the drive for the museum! And maybe for family research as well.... Check them out on Facebook.



The Fort Jones Museum is a wonderful gem too! We are researching an artist, J. F. Holtzman, who was in Fort Jones in the late 1800's. We found a newspaper







article which showed a painting he had done of Fort Jones. An internet search for a Historical Society in Fort Jones led us to the Museum – so we reached out to them – and they knew where the painting is hanging! Check them out at https://www.fortjonesmuseum.com.

And, a little closer to home – The Pioneer Museum in Oroville. Did you know that B.F. Allen and his wife, Lettuce Newbegin Woodson Allen's grandson donated their portraits to this museum? Did you know there is an oil painting done of the

Bidwell Mansion by F. Holtzman, est. in 1872, when he was in Chico and his place of business was diagonally across the street from the Mansion? Did you know the Museum has some wonderful

photos – maybe some of your family? What else might they have? Check them out on Facebook.
